

Cryosurgery (Freezing) Aftercare Instructions

Cryosurgery surgery is an excellent method of removing skin lesions. Cryosurgery involves the application of a very cold material (in this case, liquid nitrogen) which kills tissue.

Aftercare Instructions:

- Keep the area dry
- The area may "weep" or leak a clear fluid and/or form a blister. This is a common reaction.
- You may apply Vaseline or Aquaphor to the area with a bandaid covering.

It takes approximately 4-6 weeks for the wound to heal completely.
